- Certificate of Eligibility (COE) from the Department of Veterans Affairs
- DD 2214
- GI Benefits Form
- Academic Advisor Form
- IF you are using CH 33, Post 9/11, also submit the Post 911 Form

If you are using the Illinois Veterans Grant (IVG)

- Submit a copy of the Letter of Eligibility issued by the Illinois Student Assistance Commission

If you are using the Illinois National Guard Grant

- An application must be submitted for each academic year. Please identify UIC as the institution of record.
